STUDENTS PRESENTLY ON ACADEMIC PROBATION MAY NOT ATTEND SUMMER SCHOOL CLASSES.

In order to participate in the Clinic, you must have successfully completed Evidence.

If you have completed only one semester and you have completed *Contracts*, you may take only *UCC*, *Part I and Drafting Contracts* in the first session, and *UCC*, *Part 2*, and *Negotiating and Drafting Contracts and Business Agreements* in the second session.

A minimum of eight (8) people must register for a class in order for it to be offered.

If you are taking only one UCC course this summer, you will need to either take the other UCC course next summer or during the Fall semester. Both sections are necessary to complete your graduation requirements.

Your Faculty Advisor must approve and sign your course schedule before you register. Registration forms may be picked up from the Registrar's office beginning on Thursday, May 2. You may take two courses per session if you are not working full time during the summer.

You may choose to pay summer school tuition in installments. Payment is to be by check or in cash. There are no federal loans for summer school tuition. If you are attending during the first session, the first half of your tuition will be due at the time of registration (May 9) and the second half of your tuition will be due on June 15.

If you will be attending the second session, the first installment will be due at the time of registration for the second session (June 11) and the second half will be due on July 15.

There is a \$50.00 late fee for registering after May 9 and/or June 11. There is \$100.00 late fee for registering once classes have begun.

If you will be registering for a friend, please keep in mind that you may register only one person who is registering for a class which has a limited enrollment. Thus, if you wish to register yourself for a class with a limited enrollment, you may not register anyone else for a class with a limited enrollment.
